RMK is an independent company which will, as appropriate, provide project management and consulting for an online marketing campaign, coordinate marketing actions, maintain and optimize AdWords campaigns, adapt AdWords bidding strategies, optimize AdWords ads and create and optimize landing pages (the "Services"). The promotional activity will occur by email, Facebook, and Google. In exchange for the Services, the Company has agreed to provide payment of \$100,000 to RMK (the "Advertising Budget"), with an option to increase the Advertising Budget to \$250,000 during the Term at the direction of the Company. On May 1, 2024, the Company decided to increase the Advertising Budget to \$200,000 and pay an additional \$100,000 to RMK. RMK is at arm's length to the Company.
